

Atlanta Institute of Music and Media
Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students Under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
Economic Security (CARES) Act

The U.S. Department of Education has made Emergency Financial Aid Grants available to Atlanta Institute of Music and Media (AIMM) students who need financial support for their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to Coronavirus. This application permits students to apply for these need-based grants.

AIMM administration will determine student eligibility to receive a grant and the amount of money students will be eligible for based on the overall enrollments of the institution. Students must file a [2020-2021 FAFSA](#) (whether or not you currently participate in federal financial aid) and must be actively enrolled and in good standing to be eligible to receive this grant.

The Emergency Financial Aid Grant will be evenly disseminated to actively enrolled students over the next two terms (summer and fall quarters) 30 days after the start date of each term.

Only one application will be considered per student.
